

SRHS DRESS CODE

FROM pp. 5-6 THE 2009-2010 STUDENT HANDBOOK

For the school and classroom situation, students are to observe modesty, appropriateness, and neatness in clothing and personal appearance. The following regulations concerning dress and grooming are deemed necessary in order to comply with the requirements of proper personal appearance.

Note consequences in the Discipline Section of handbook.

- 1) Students must wear footwear at all times. **NO SLIPPERS.**
- 2) Wearing apparel should not be revealing or immodest and should be clean, neat, and mended. **Swim or sleep wear** are not allowed at school.
- 3) Midriffs may not be exposed. No tops with low or revealing necklines. Halters, backless and strapless tops, fishnet shirts, sheer shirts, shirts and dresses with one shoulder, tank tops or spaghetti straps, etc., may not be worn. Shoulders must be completely covered and shirts must have sleeves. Boys' tank tops are not allowed unless a t-shirt is worn underneath.
- 4) Female students wearing tops that appear too short (either while standing or sitting) will be asked to raise their arms over their heads. If the midriff is exposed, the student will report to in-school suspension for the day or parent must provide appropriate clothing to the student.
- 5) Shorts, skirts, and dresses may be worn; however, they may not be revealing or immodest. It is strongly suggested that they be knee length. They **MUST** be at least mid thigh length. **NO "SHORT" SHORTS!**
- 6) Spandex, bicycle pants, and leotards may be worn only when they are covered with shorts, skirt, or a long top. Leotard/spandex type clothing is not considered a substitute for pants. Pants must be worn at the waist above the hip bone. Any pants that drag on the ground are too long, unacceptable and present a safety hazard.
- 7) Undergarments should not be seen or visible through clothing for both male and female students.
- 8) **Boys and girls may not wear hats, caps, bandanas, wave caps, stocking caps, "hoods" up, sunglasses or visors, wristbands and headbands, etc., to school. Combs are not permitted to be in hair. Hats will be held in administrative office. No jewelry with spikes/studs, or long chains (or other items that could be considered dangerous) may be worn to school.**
- 9) No clothing or paraphernalia bearing names, symbols, or slogans of other schools may be worn to class or to any other school event.
- 10) Inappropriate articles of clothing and pins that disrupt the learning process are not permitted. Such items include, but are not limited to references to guns, drugs, alcoholic beverages, tobacco products, gangs, cults, and vulgar or suggestive phrases or pictures.
- 11) No long trench coat type garments or hoods are allowed.
- 12) No shirts depicting "Scarface" or cash transactions (including the \$ sign) are to be worn to school
- 13) **The administration of the school shall have the authority to judge whether or not the appearance of any student is disruptive to the educational function of the school or school activity.**
- 14) Students violating the dress code will be removed from class and placed in in-school suspension for the remainder of the day or parent must provide appropriate clothing to the student.
- 15) Ipod/MP3 players or any other electronic devices are not allowed on campus and should not be seen. This does not include calculators.
