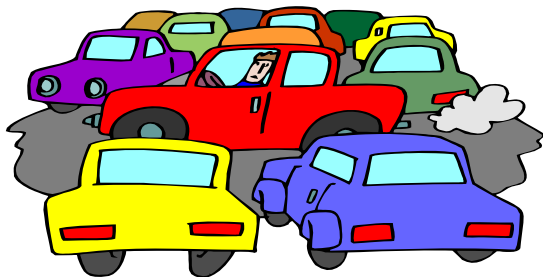
PTSA News.....

Have You Heard?

eSembler is a tool that will allow you to monitor your child's grades and attendance. Signing up is easy and takes only a few minutes.

Create an Account

In order to create an account, you must have an existing e-mail account. Your e-mail address will be your user name.

1. Click on the eSembler icon on the SRHS home page (www.go-sharks.org).
2. Click **New Account**
3. Fill in the required fields. Note that the password for your eSembler account must be at least 6 characters.
4. Be sure to read the *Terms and Conditions* and check the box.
5. Review the instructions and then click **ok**.
6. An activation email will be sent to the email address you provided in step 3.
7. Follow the directions in the activation email. You will have to click on a link to activate your account.

If you receive an error message saying that the student information does not match, contact the school office at 564-4170.

eSembler verifies its student data from the District's Student Information System. Parents are required to provide documentation to the school for verification. This information is initially required at the time of enrollment and if any changes are necessary.

Next...Add Students

Once you have created an account, you must **Add Students**.

1. Log in to your eSembler account.
2. Click **Add Student**.
3. Enter the following information about the student: Student ID number, Student Name, Last 4 digits of SSN, Birth date, and Grade Level. Click **Save**.
4. Repeat steps 2 and 3 to add more students.

Check Grades and Attendance

- After you have added a student, click on his/her name to view grades and attendance.
- Click on a class or the letter grade to see the current average, dates of absences and teacher contact information.
- You can customize what you see on these screens by clicking *Preferences* and turning various items on or off.
- You can also print this grade sheet.

Frequently Asked Questions

When are grades updated?
Usually as soon as the teacher inputs them.

I'm a student and I want to check my grades. How do I do it?
To access your information, follow the instructions above for creating an account, and then add yourself as a student.

I have a question about a grade. Who should I contact?
If you have a question about your child's grade in a class, contact the teacher. Teacher phone numbers and email addresses can be found on the [go-sharks.org](http://www.go-sharks.org) website under *Faculty*.

It says my child has Missing Scores. Did he not turn something in?

Understand that there are two separate items, *Missing Scores* and *Missing Assignments*. If you see that your child has *Missing Scores*, don't panic.

Missing Score simply means that a score has not been entered for your child on an assignment. *Missing Score* does not necessarily mean that the assignment was not submitted or completed by your child; it just means that the teacher has not yet entered a grade for the student on an assignment.

Missing Assignments don't yet appear on eSembler.

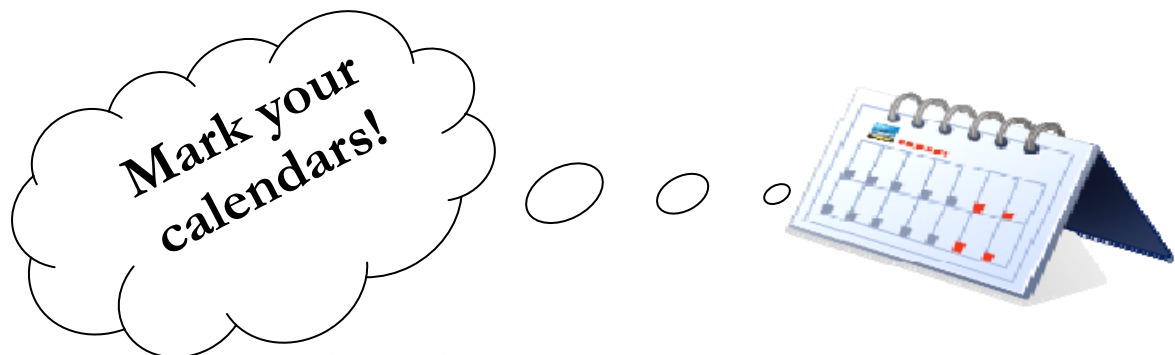

CELLA Testing

(Comprehensive English Language Learning Assessment)

This test is given each Spring to all current and some former ESOL students throughout the state of Florida. This assessment tests students in the four basic areas of Listening, Speaking, Reading and Writing. The test takes approximately 3 hours to complete and will be administered during the last week of April. Scores are used to evaluate ESOL Program effectiveness and may also be used as one criteria to determine “exiting” students from the ESOL Program.



SRHS IB Exams 2010

IB exams will be given at IRCC’s Mueller center. IB juniors and seniors will be excused from school on the days they are testing. A more specific calendar with times and room numbers will be disseminated well in advance of the examinations. A list of students will also be sent to teachers prior to the exam weeks.
