

## **Driving Instructions to Vero Beach High School**

### **From the North:**

Take I-75 and the Turnpike to Yeehaw Junction Exit and go East on SR 60 or I-95 South to the SR Route 60 Vero Beach Exit. Continue with "From the West" below...

### **From the West:**

Go East on SR Route 60 into town. (about 5 miles or so)  
Proceed to 43<sup>rd</sup> Ave. Look for 2 Mobile Gas Stations one on the Left and one on the Right. Turn South (Right) on 43<sup>rd</sup> Ave. Proceed South to 16<sup>th</sup> Street (Next Light). Turn Left (East) and Continue Until you pass to the east of the School. You will see the Stadium on the Left and the Performing Arts Center on the Right. The Traffic Light is 17<sup>th</sup> Ave. Turn Left (South) into the parking lot as directed by our staff. This lot is ONLY for Buses, Trucks/Trailers to Unload. We do not have room for parking in this lot for vehicles other than to unload. All parking will be to the North of the Stadium.

### **From the South:**

Take I-95 North to the Indrio Road Exit between Ft. Pierce and Vero Beach. Go East on Indrio @ SR 713 (Traffic Light also Known as Kings Hwy) and turn North (Left). Follow SR 713 North & East as it curves over to U.S. 1. Go North on U.S. 1 to 17th Street in Vero Beach. Go West (Left) on 17th Street. It will become 16th Street as you continue. Stack your vehicles in the left turn lane as you approach the School and the Stadium (On Right) and Performing Arts Center (On Left) at 17th Ave (traffic light). Turn Left (South) into the parking lot as directed by our staff. This lot is ONLY for Buses, Trucks/Trailers to Unload.

### **Bus, Equipment Truck, and Spectator Parking:**

The parking and unloading areas near the Performing Arts Center and for unloading only, vehicles will need to park across the street and behind the stadium in the grass field or to the west of the soft ball fields northwest of the campus. See map. This will be a logistics problem for all schools and access to your busses and trucks will need to be well planned and thought out before arrival. Busses and trucks will be able to come and go only for brief loading or unloading purposes only.
